AN UNDERESTIMATED ECOLOGICAL IMPACTTHE CURRENT SITUATION

The current management of used carpets is disastrous. With almost nonexistent reuse and recycling channels, nearly all of these carpets are either incinerated or sent to landfills, resulting in very negative environmental consequences.



The combustion of carpets emits toxic gases and contributes to air pollution, while their degradation in landfills contaminates the soil and ecosystems.

The construction sector is a major consumer of natural resources and generates a considerable amount of waste. In this context, the European Union, with the Green Deal, aims to accelerate the energy efficiency of buildings.
